### ABOUT THE INITIATIVE

Looking for up to \$500 to support a school project, purchase classroom resources, or meet an educational need? Here's your chance...

The P&C is offering \$500 each term to support or partially fund school-related projects or initiatives. Teachers with ideas to enhance the classroom, year level, or school community are encouraged to apply. The funds are intended for projects that improve the teaching and learning environment at MacGregor State School. Whether it's an innovative idea, a research-backed approach, or something that benefits the learning experience for students and staff, we want to hear from you.

### APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

1. You need to be a current teacher at MacGregor State School.
2. You must be able to manage the funds if your application is approved.
3. You are required to present your proposal, including quotes, at a P&C meeting (held on the third Tuesday of each month).

### FUNDING CRITERIA:

1. The project must commence within two months of receiving the funds.
2. A single financial grant of up to \$500 will be provided each term, or multiple payments totaling up to \$500 for separate projects.
3. Funding is available for resources, programs, or special projects.
4. Applicants may apply for funding in multiple rounds each year.
5. Funding can be granted in portions each term, with a maximum total of \$500.

## MSS P&C EDUCATIONAL INNOVATION FUND - APPLICATION PROCESS:

Please email the P&C at [secretary@msspc.org.au](mailto:secretary@msspc.org.au) with the required information outlined below. As part of the application process, you'll need to briefly attend a P&C meeting to present your proposal and answer any questions.

Each term, up to \$500 is available through one funding round. Joint applications are permitted, and the \$500 can be divided among several smaller projects. Applications can be submitted at any time during the term. You'll need to present your project at a P&C meeting during that term. The P&C will review all applications and make decisions at the beginning of the following term, with funds allocated for use during that term. Unsuccessful applications may be resubmitted in future terms.
